AND WHEREAS nothing contained in this deed shall be deemed to authorize the trustees to do any act which may in any way be construed statutory modifications thereof and all activities of the trust shall be carried out with a view to benefit the public at large, without any profit motive and in accordance with the provisions of the Income-tax Act, 1961 or any statutory modification thereof.

AND WHEREAS the trust is hereby expressly declared to be a public charitable trust and all the provisions of this deed are to be constituted accordingly.

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSTH AS FOLLOWS :

1. SETTLEMENT

The party of the first part, the settlor, does hereby settle the sum of Rs.29,000/- (Rupees Twenty Nine Thousand only) in Trust, with the name and for the objects hereinafter stated, by delivering the said amount in cash which the party of the other part, the Trustees, have accepted the receipt of which they do hereby acknowledge, to hold the same in and to the Trustees with the powers and obligations as provided hereinafter.

2. NAME

The name of the Trust shall be "GADA BIRAJA TAMULI TRUST".

3. PLACE :

The principal office of the Trust shall be situated at G.B.Tamuli Commerical Complex, Sonapur, Old Market, Kamrup(M), Assam or such other place as the Trustees may from time to time decide. The Trust may also carry on its work at any other place or places, as decided by the Trustees.

4. OBJECTS

a. Education -

- i. to run, maintain or assist any educational or other institution for coaching, guidance, counseling or vocational training or to grant individual scholarships for poor, deserving and needy students for elementary and higher education.
- ii. To work for the promotion of education and to establish educational institutions for students, children and youth;

- iii. To establish, maintain and run Schools, Colleges, University, Social centres.
- iv. To establish allied education institutions.
- v. To spread education and learning in all branches more specifically in Arts, Science and Technology
- vi. To acquire and maintain movables and immovable's properties for achieving the said objects.
- vii. To advance any other objects of general public utility
- viii. To confer title on eminent personality in the field of science, education, literature etc.
- b. Medical - to run, maintain or assist any medical institution, nursing home or clinics or to grant assistance to needy and indigent persons for meeting the cost of medical treatment.
- c. Relief of the poor - to give financial or other assistance in kind by way of distribution of books, notebooks, cloths, uniforms, or meals for the poor and indigent and to the persons suffer due to natural calamities.
- e. Other objects of general public utility -
 - i. to acquire property for the sole use for public good by making it available for public purposes as for example, housing a library clinic, Orphanage, Old Age Home, Dharamsala, a community Hall to be available for public use as training classes, seminars, discourses and other public functions for benefit of the community in general.
 - ii. to provide literacy and education and to lay emphasis on primary, secondary, university and technical education, specially for the weaker and underprivileged section of the society and to set-up institutions and establishments for the same and for the upliftment of the Schedule Tribe, Schedule Caste and Minority Communities & alongwith other communities.

- iii. to promote female education and create awareness among the girls and women and to establish schools, residential schools, colleges, hostels coaching center, technical institutions and vocational training centers for girls and women and also for boys.
- iv. to create awareness about sanitation, hygiene and health and to establish hospitals, nursing homes, health centers nursing training centers, midwifery training centers and to organize health care centers, medical check-up camps and such other allied activities.
- v. to organize, manage, maintain and run Education Movement, Social and Educational caravan, Work-shop, Training Programs, Symposia, Meetings and such other programs for the promotion of education and literacy among the people in general and minorities and backward section of the society in particulars.
- vi. to run, maintain, establish, assist any kind of educational Organizations including special residential and non-residential schools, for Orphanages & physically handicapped, residential schools from primary level to higher Degree College and University.
- vii. to establish and maintain adult education centers specially in the Rural Areas and in Slums for eradicating illiteracy and ignorance and to appoint teachers and supervisors for managements of such centers.
- viii. to undertake any other activity incidental to the above activities but which are not inconsistent with the above objects.

PROVIDED the Trust may assist/donate the other TRUST to carry out the various objects mentioned in the objects clause in such manner and to the extent the Trustees may decide upon from time to time.

5. FUNDS

The Trustees may accept donations, grants, subscriptions, aids or contributions from any person, Government, Local authorities or any other charitable institutions, in cash or in kind including

immovable property without any incumbrance, but the Trustees shall not accept any receipt with any condition or terms inconsistent with the objects of the Trusts. While applying such receipts to the objects, the Trustees shall respect the directions, if any, by the granter. Any receipt with specific direction to treat the same as part of the corpus of the Trust or separate fund shall be funded accordingly.

To collect and disseminate the knowledge acquired by study, research and actions through documentation, publications, exhibitions newsletters, poster, films, documentary, electronics media and slide-shows, puppetry, workshop, training programmes as well as the planning and implementation of development and education related programmes and activities, electronic.

To alienate by way of sale, mortgage, lease, release, loan, charge, hypothecation, pledge, exchange, hiring, gift, or otherwise with or without security, the properties or funds of the trust or any portion or portions thereof as the Board of Trustees may deem fit for carrying out the objectives of the Trust and day-to-day running of the Trust according to law. To place money in banks as securities against loans offered by the same banks to poor and needy persons for the purpose of building their own houses, constructing a community structure, carrying out activities in industry or agriculture or for any other purpose Board of Trustees may deem proper.

6. INVESTMENTS

- i. All money which shall not immediately required for current needs shall be invested by the Trustees in eligible securities and investments, or in banks. Such investments shall be in the name of Trust or Trustees.
- ii. That the trustees shall invest the trust fund, carry on any business with the trust fund and/or enter into partnership on behalf of the trust, as they may deem fit.

- iii. That the trustees shall manage the trust fund and investments thereof as a prudent man would do the same. They shall recover all outstandings and meet all recurring and other expenses incurred in the upkeep or management thereof.

7. POWER OF TRUSTEES

That the trustees shall have the following powers : . to manage all the assets and/or properties of the trust including the conduct of business;

- iv. to sell, alter, vary, transpose or otherwise dispose or alienate the trust properties or any investment representing the same for consideration and to reinvest the same; v. to pledge or mortgage the trust properties for raising loans;
- v. to open the bank accounts in the name and on behalf of the trust and to operate the same;
- vi. To enter into a partnership on behalf of the trust with any other party or parties;
- vii. To pay all charges, impositions and other outgoings payable in respect of the trust properties and also to pay all cost of the incidental to the administration and management of the trust properties;

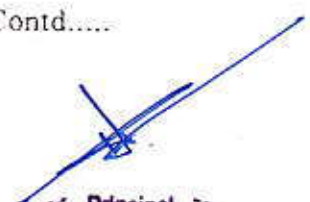

- viii. To file suit on behalf of the trust and to refer to arbitration all actions proceedings and disputes touching the trust properties and to compromise and compound the suits filed;
- ix. To accept any gift, donation or contribution in cash or in kind from anyone for the objects of the trust;
- x. To seek legal opinion of lawyers and/or Chartered Accountants as and when required; xii. To nominate their representatives for any of the aforesaid purposes.
- 8. The number of the trustees shall not be less than two but the Trustee may induct other person(s) as trustees into the trust but in no circumstances the number of trustees will exceed Eleven, that is the total strength of the trustees will confine only to 11 and the existing trustees may induct other competent person(s) having social interest, high degree character and proper qualification by majority of the opinion of the existing trustee.
- 9. That Sri Sushil Kumar Tamuli will be the Managing Trustee of the trust during his lifetime and in case of any difference between the trustees, the opinion of the majority shall prevail.
- 10. Every trustee will be at liberty to nominate or appoint attorneys or agents and to delegate all or any of the duties and powers vested in him to such attorney or agent, and to remove such attorney or agent and reappoint other or others in his place.
- 11. No trustee shall be responsible or liable for any loss or any act of omission or commission by his constituted attorney or agent or employees or other trustees unless occasioned by his willful neglect or default.

12. That the aforesaid trustees will function as trustees during their lifetime and/or till they are removed or disqualified, whichever is earlier, in accord with the rules and regulations to be framed by the trustees and in case of death or vacancy otherwise of any trustee, such vacant post will be filled up by the majority of votes of the existing and surviving trustees
13. If at any time the number of the trustees is less than two, the existing trustee shall appoint one or more trustees.
14. That the trustees will be bound to fulfill the purpose of the trust and to obey the directions/terms and conditions contained in this deed, or the rules and regulations to be framed by the trustees.
15. Upon the appointment of a new trustee the trust properties shall vest in the new trustee jointly with the continuing or surviving trustees, with the duties and power of the trustees set out hereinabove in this deed.
16. If the trust is determined by efflux of time, the corpus of the trust shall be divided amongst the beneficiaries in the shares as fixed by the trustees.
17. **BANKING ACCOUNT**
 - i. All income, subscription and pecuniary donations for the general purposes of the Trust and the income, investments and all other money from time to time forming part of the general revenue of the Trust shall on the same being received be paid into a banking account with any nationalised bank for the purpose of the Trust.
 - ii. The bank accounts shall be operated by the Author/Settlor alongwith any one of the remaining Trustees.

18. ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT . The Trustee shall keep proper books of account of all the assets, liabilities and income and expenditure of the Trust and shall prepare an Income and Expenditure Account and Balance Sheet for every year as on the last day of March. i. The accounts of every year shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant or a firm of Chartered Accountants who shall be appointed for that purpose by the Trustees and the audited accounts shall be placed at a meeting of the Trustees, which shall be held before the end of the succeeding year.
20. The trustees may amalgamate the trust with another Charitable Trust or Institution having similar objects with prior permission of the Charity Commissioner/Court/any other law as may be applicable for the time being.
21. That when a trustee will commit breach of trust, he will be liable to make good the loss which the trust property or the beneficiary has thereby sustained, unless the beneficiary has by fraud induced the trustee to commit the breach or the beneficiary, being competent in contract, has himself, without any coercion or undue influence having been brought to bear on him, occurred in the breach, or subsequent acquiescence therein, with full knowledge of the facts of the case and his rights as against the trustees.
22. That in the event of dissolution or winding up of the Trust the assets remaining as on the date of dissolution shall under no circumstances be distributed amongst the Trustees but the same shall be transferred to some other similar Trust/Organisation whose objects are similar to those of this Trust with the permission of the Charity Commissioner / Court / any other law as may be applicable for the time being. The Trustees shall be indemnified against all losses and liabilities incurred by them in the execution of the Trust and shall have a lien over the funds and properties of the Trust for such indemnity.

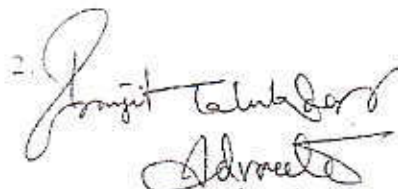
